At this function CMIA delegation appraised Mr.A.M.Khan about the various important points taken up related to growth & development of Marathwada Region for which CMIA is in constant touch with Chief Minister, Hon.Mr.Ashokraoji Chavan, ever since July,09.

CMIA delegation expressed that the following issues be addressed on the topmost priority for ensuring the Growth & Development of Marathwada Region.

1. Take special efforts in attracting fresh investment and New Industries in Marathwada region and especially in Aurangabad for creating new job opportunities for local talented youths.
2. Government of Maharashtra need to support "Maha Expo-The Mega Exhibition", being hosted at Aurangabad for show-casing the potential of Marathwada region and attracting fresh investments.

3. To complete the project of creating world class International Convention Centre at Aurangabad to meet the basic infrastructural requirement at Aurangabad
4. Extend all possible support for the execution of Marathwada Auto Cluster Project at Aurangabad which has got enormous potential to promote Aurangabad as Auto hub on International arena.
5. To establish the Technology University at Aurangabad immediately & also work for starting premier education institutes like IIT/IIM/IIIT at Aurangabad.
6. Promote Aurangabad as important International Tourist destination and create required infrastructure for the same. Focus on improving air and rail connectivity of Aurangabad with all key business and tourist destinations in the country. Ensure International flights commence from Aurangabad immediately.
7. To focus on the Completion of Parallel/Alternate pipeline project at Aurangabad for ensuring adequate water supply to city as well as industrial area and to make provision to ensure that there is no water supply shortage to the city for next 20 years.
8. To focus on implementing Pune model of electricity distribution so that there is no scarcity of power for industrial area and no load shedding is required. If needed work for creating captive power plant to meet electricity requirement of the city.
9. To explore the possibility of tapping the Gas Pipeline in Ahmednagar District and bringing it up to Aurangabad-Jalna for meeting the requirement of local industries.
10. Focus on completion of the four-laneing highway of connecting Nashik-Aurangabad-Pune sector of the Golden Quadrilateral Project.

CMIA delegation requested prompt attention of Industries Secretary on the above-mentioned issues and best possible support and co-operation for the Growth and Development of Marathwada Region.
