

## **GRAND CIVIC RECEPTION TO INDUSTRY MINISTER**

Hon.Industries Minister, Shri Rajendra Darda was offered civic felicitation on Saturday 21st November,09 at CIDCO Auditorium. This

programme was organized by Rajendra Darda Nagari Satkar Kruti Samiti to offer civic reception to the minister to mark his birthday as well as his inclusion in the State Cabinet. Mr. Balasaheb Vikhe Patil, Veteran Co-op. movement leader, former MP, Former Union Minister was the chief guest of this grand programme. On this occasion Mr. Vikhe Patil said that Congress President Sonia Gandhi and Prime Minister Dr. Manmohan Singh and Chief Minister Ashokraoji Chavan have entrusted the responsibility of Industry Minister on Rajendra Darda looking at his ability. This is a great challenge and by accepting it Rajendra Darda will give a new vision to Industrial Development in Maharashtra.

While replying to the civic felicitation, Hon. Darda made few announcements. He said Aurangabad now features on the list, a development that would prove helpful for the city in the next 30 years. The DMIC will pass through Maharashtra and Aurangabad District 150 Kms area to left and right of the line is covered in the corridor.

Further Hon. Darda said that The Chamber of Marathwada Industries and Agriculture (CMIA) had been gunning for the Auto Cluster Project in Aurangabad for the last six years. He announced that the Union Government on November 13 sanctioned Rs. 60 Crore for Aurangabad's Auto Cluster Project, which will benefit 1200 automobile units located here. He also added that 15 acres land has been allotted to Sterlite in Shendra Industrial Estate and the company's electronic unit, which was to be moved to Uttaranchal, will now be set up in Shendra.
